- \_\_\_ 2. Modifier key that, used in combination with text, makes a letter uppercase.
- \_\_\_ 3. Used to erase characters to the right of the insertion point.
- \_\_\_ 4. Adds a space at the insertion point.
- \_\_\_ 5. Indents the insertion point or text.
- \_\_\_ 6. When turned on, locks the alphabet keys so that all letters are uppercase.
- \_\_\_ 7. Moves the insertion point up, down, left, or right without creating spaces or deleting text.
- \_\_\_ 8. This keyboard command inserts a hard page break at a specific point.
- \_\_\_ 9. Used to erase characters to the left of the insertion point.
- \_\_\_ 10. Can be used for different commands, depending on the program. Often used with modifier keys.
- \_\_\_ 11. A keyboard command that lets you keep both hands on the keyboard instead of using the mouse.
- \_\_\_ 12. Press this key and the N key to open a new document.
- \_\_\_ 13. The Alt, Ctrl, and Shift keys are all examples of this type of key.
- \_\_\_ 14. The symbol that shows where you will be entering text or data on the screen.
