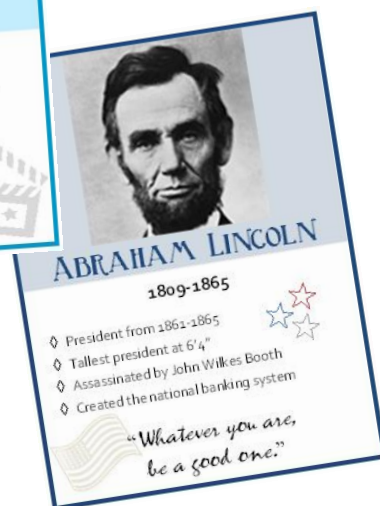
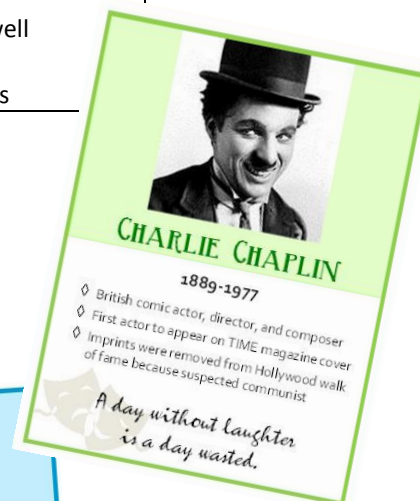


TRADING CARDS

- Use 8.5x11 landscape style page
- Set margins at 0.25"
- Set grid guides with 3 columns and 2 rows with 0.2" spacing between each
- Must have a total of 6 cards, 5 on a person from one of the decades above, and 1 about yourself
- Each card must have:
 - the person's name
 - date of birth, and death if deceased
 - at least 3 facts
 - quote from the person
 - a picture of the person
 - a picture that represents them
 - a border around the each card
- **Remember your C.R.A.P. principles.** Use contrast in colors, fonts etc., Repetition where needed. Alignment and proximity to keep things organized.
- Your cards **should not** have to look just like mine. Use your creativity and originality. 😊
